I can even stay on Froo Ties when she occasionally jumps over Level 3 at Level 1 height – I would have definitely taken a tumble if that had happened at the beginning of this year.

Just as an endorsement for Carly's skills (and a little bit of the temperament my now late stallion Troupa Ties) Rosette Ties the little chestnut TB mare featured in the photos, was started by Carly – in addition to the ribbons you see her winning above she has also taken out first place in her 3rd Dressage outing at level 4 – Go Carly and Rosie now 6yo.

Carly is now in the process of starting Holly (Sovereign Ties), Rosie's full and look alike sister. Looking forward to good things – still heaps more work to do but good to take stock ☺
