

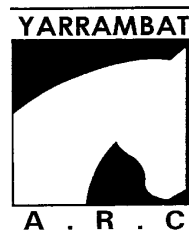

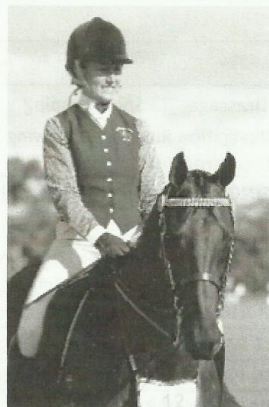


CAN I WEAR A JACKET?

Riding or hacking jackets must not be worn in HRCav competition. Our rules are quite clear on this. Riders must wear their Club colours and the expectation is that competitors present themselves as neatly and professionally as possible. In Showing, most competitors seem to favour the tailored vest and these are very smart. If wearing a vest, you need to ensure that your shirt/skivvy is of a contrasting colour. A tailored vest with matching coloured shirt sleeves very closely resembles a jacket and is not permitted.

At our winter woollies shows we have been seeing other types of jackets in the ring. Soft shell jackets are popular and they can be smart, warm and comfortable. Shown below are examples of soft shell jacket designs. As long as the jacket is not designed for use as a competition riding/hacking jacket, and it is in your club colours, it may be worn.

If it is cold and wet, the judge or ground jury may allow riders to wear a waterproof coat or jacket over their uniform. Make sure that you check with the judge if a general announcement has not been made.

WHAT ABOUT THE LOGO?

One of the most commonly asked questions is 'do I have to show my club logo on my vest/top/saddle blanket?' Our rules state that **Club colours** must be worn on the rider's upper body with the Club name or logo displayed on the upper body garment and/or saddle blanket. You have 3 choices.

- Display the logo on your upper body garment
- Display the logo on the saddle blanket or
- Display the logo on the upper body garment and the saddle blanket.

In Led classes, the requirement to display the logo is waived to accommodate competitors who have the logo on the saddle blanket only.
